Dear Parents or Carers,

Re: Information regarding confirmed cases of coronavirus in Llangynwyd Primary School

We have been made aware of a rise in positive Covid cases in our school community.

So far, a number of classes have been affected.

Llangynwyd Primary School remains open. We are working closely to ensure that all the appropriate measures are in place to protect students, staff and the wider community. This letter is to inform you of the current situation and to provide advice on how to support your child.

As a precaution, please be alert for any symptoms of COVID-19 in your children:

- A new or continuous cough
- A high temperature
- A loss of or change to sense of smell or taste

If your child develops any of these symptoms, even if they are mild:

- Inform **Mrs Kehoe, Deputy Headteacher of Llangynwyd Primary School** that your child is unwell with COVID-19 symptoms.
- Your child should stay at home until symptoms reside or until they have a negative test result.

To reduce the risk of COVID-19 spreading, there are things that everyone in your family can do to help. These include:

- washing hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
- using hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- washing hands as soon as they get home

- covering their mouth and nose with a tissue or sleeve (not their hands) when they cough or sneeze
- putting used tissues in the bin immediately and washing hands afterwards

Since September, we have been operating more openly as school began to return to normal. However, due to the spike in cases within our school environment, we have returned to some mitigation measures in line with our school risk assessment to limit the mixing of pupils in different classes to slow the spread as much as we can. By working together, we will be able to keep our school community safe.
